### ***SOUTH GENERAL AVIATION LIGHTING PROJECT***

Separate sealed bids for the construction of Apron Lighting – South General Aviation Area, Hector International Airport, Fargo, North Dakota, according to the drawings and specifications on file in the office of the Executive Director will be received by Municipal Airport Authority at its office until 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, June 22, 2004, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be upon the basis of cash payment for: Lighting poles and bases, fixtures, conduit, conductor, trenching, conduit boring, electrical controls and incidentals.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a Bidder's Bond in a sum equal to five percent of the full amount of the Bid, executed by the Bidder as principal and by a surety company authorized to do business in this state, conditioned that if the principal's Bid be accepted and the contract awarded to him, he, within fifteen days after Notice of Award, will execute and effect a contract in accordance with the terms of his Bid and a Contractor's Bond as required by law and the regulations and determinations of the governing board. The Bid Bond of the three lowest Bidders will be retained until the contract has been awarded and executed, but no longer than sixty (60) days. The Bid security is a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into contract for the work described in the Proposal.

All Bidders shall hold a valid North Dakota Contractor's license of the proper class and shall enclose a copy of the license or Certificate of Renewal of the license in the same envelope as the Bidder's Bond.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish Contract Performance and Payment Bonds in the full amount of the contract.

No Bid will be read or considered which does not fully comply with the above provisions as to Bond and licenses, and any deficient Bid submitted will be resealed and returned to the Bidder immediately.

The work on the improvement is to be entirely completed by October 30, 2004.

The right of the Owner to reject any and all Bids is reserved.
