PROPOSED ELEVATED ENCLOSED WALKWAY
DEADLINE EXTENDED**

The Municipal Airport Authority of the City of Fargo, North Dakota is seeking qualification information from qualified firms to provide architectural services relating to the planning, design, specifications, bidding and possible construction of an elevated enclosed walkway that will be located at Hector International Airport in Fargo, North Dakota. This request for qualifications is made in accordance with the Federal Aviation Administration Advisory Circular 150/5100-14E.

The purpose of the elevated enclosed walkway is to provide shelter for customers that walk between the passenger terminal and pay parking lot especially during inclement weather conditions. The proposed elevated enclosed walkway would connect to the passenger terminal and extend to the south through a portion of the pay parking lot.

The RFQ information will be accepted through **4:00PM on Tuesday October 11, 2016** after which the information will be evaluated. Interested firms shall submit a maximum of 10 pages of information pertaining to their qualifications to complete the services requested for the project. Please provide six copies of your completed RFQ response.
