AIRPORT MASTER PLAN UPDATE -  
PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

The Municipal Airport Authority will be holding a public Open House on September 13, 2016 from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM in the Boardroom located on the second floor of the Terminal Building at 2801 32nd Avenue North, Fargo, North Dakota 58102.

Attendees can park in the hourly or daily lot located to the south of the Terminal Building and should bring their ticket stub to the meeting. The Municipal Airport Authority will then validate the ticket stub for free parking upon leaving the lot.

The Open House will be an opportunity for the general public to learn about the airport's ongoing Master Plan Study and examine the preferred alternatives which resulted from analyzing future development considerations at the airport. The public will have the opportunity to provide comments concerning the project and the airport's future direction. There is no formal presentation planned; attendees will be able to view presentation materials at their own pace and ask questions of the Municipal Airport Authority staff and consultants.

Comments and suggestions received during the Open House are to be evaluated by the project team and incorporated into the study as appropriate. The proposed improvements are intended to achieve compliance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulations and to meet the existing and projected aviation needs of the region.
